SOLICITATIONS

Code GAIA/B Issued 12/15/21

Solicitations by and of employees shall be kept to a minimum.

No organization may solicit funds of employees within the schools or distribute flyers or other materials related to fund drives through the schools without the written approval of the superintendent or his/her designee.

No employee shall sell or distribute anything to students, parents/legal guardians or employees for profit or other personal gain in or about the school or school grounds where he/she is employed or through the use of the district's technology.

Any funds or items received as the result of solicitations in the name of the school, a school or district program, or the district in general – including grants, solicited donations or unsolicited donations – become the property of the district.

No solicitations can be collected in the name of the school, a school or district program, or the district in general – including grants without the expressed permission of the superintendent/designee
