TUTORING FOR PAY

Code GBRGB Issued 12/15/21

An employee may enter into an agreement with parents/legal guardians for tutoring children for a fee. This practice must be limited to children other than those for whom the employee is currently exercising teaching, administrative, or supervisory responsibility. These restrictions are to assure all students receive reasonable assistance without charge from their own teachers, as well as to avoid placing a teacher in a position where he/she may have a conflict of interest.

An employee may not tutor any student for pay during his/her regular working hours or on school premises.

These agreements are between the parents/legal guardians and the employee, and the district assumes no responsibility for monitoring these activities.
