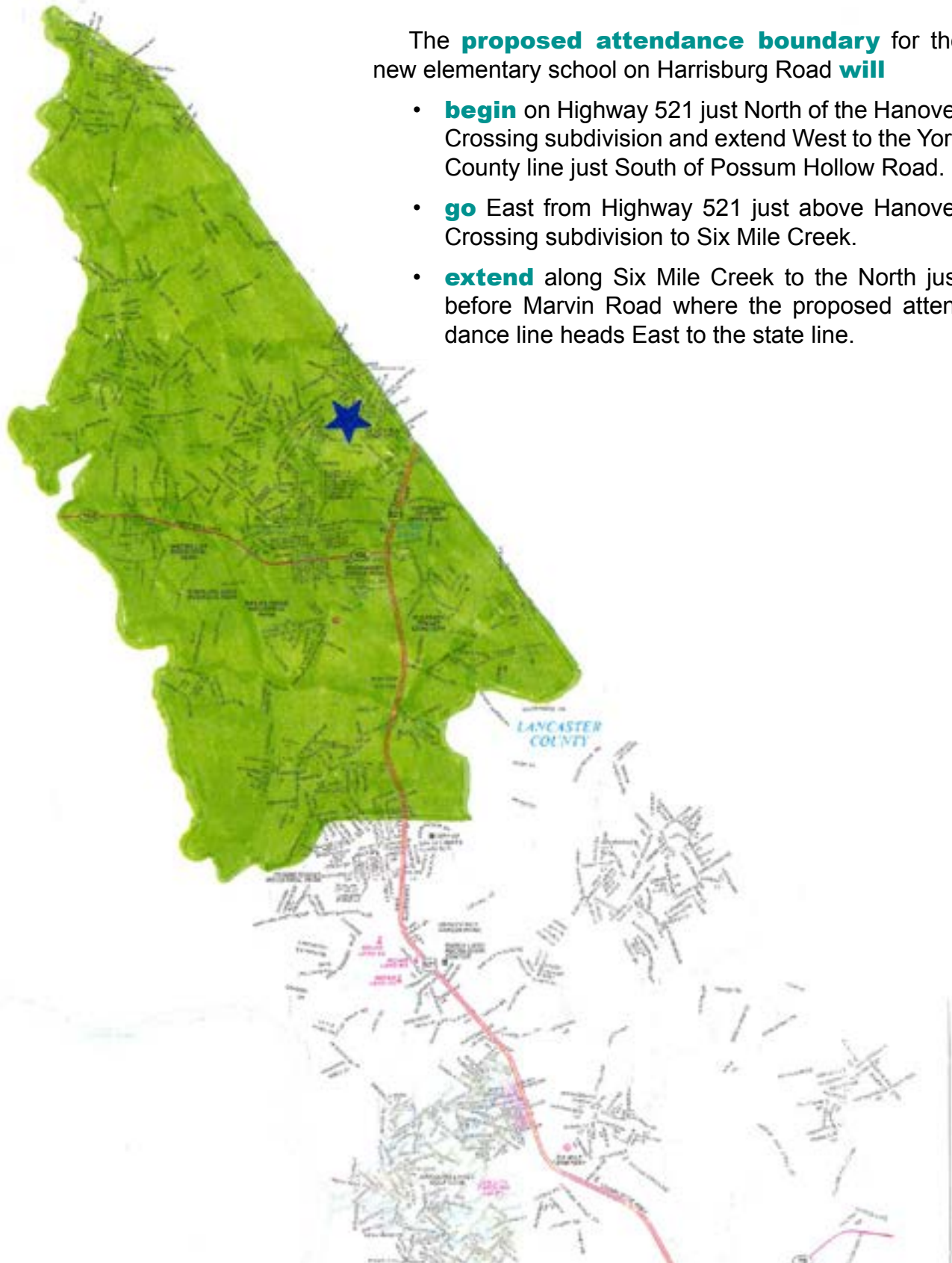


Map of Boundaries

Attendance Lines for New Elementary School on Harrisburg Road

The **proposed attendance boundary** for the new elementary school on Harrisburg Road **will**

- **begin** on Highway 521 just North of the Hanover Crossing subdivision and extend West to the York County line just South of Possum Hollow Road.
- **go** East from Highway 521 just above Hanover Crossing subdivision to Six Mile Creek.
- **extend** along Six Mile Creek to the North just before Marvin Road where the proposed attendance line heads East to the state line.
