

## **USC Lancaster Dual Enrollment and Concurrent Enrollment**

Dual and Concurrent enrollment at USC Lancaster provides high achieving high school students with the opportunity to take college courses that will enhance their junior and senior year experience while experiencing the challenges of a collegiate classroom setting.

The USC Lancaster Dual enrollment courses allow students to receive high school and college credit for a course. These courses are taught on the high school campus by approved USC adjunct professors. Currently, Lancaster School District is on a 3-year cycle for dual enrollment courses. Only junior and senior students are allowed to enroll in the dual enrollment program. This allows a Lancaster school district student to obtain 12 hours of college credit prior to high school graduation. If a student decides to participate in the high school dual enrollment course, he/she will receive AP weighting for the course on their high school transcript and receive college credit.

Another option for those high achieving students is concurrent enrollment. These courses allow students to receive only college credit for a course. These courses are taken on the USC Lancaster campus giving the high school student the complete college experience. Concurrent enrollment eases the transition as students leave high school and participate in a true university setting. Students are exposed to collegiate instruction in traditional USC Lancaster classrooms with USC Lancaster faculty and traditional college students. The school district has the option to accept concurrent courses as high school credit.

### **To qualify for enrollment, a student must:**

- Have a 3.0 high school GPA
- Confirm US citizenship
- Confirm South Carolina residency
- Official High School transcript
- ACT/SAT/ or PSAT scores
- Letter of recommendation

### **Cost:**

For the school year 2014-2015, tuition rate for dual enrollment is \$95 per credit hour. The majority of dual enrollment courses are 3 credit hours or \$285 per course. The tuition rate is the same for dual enrollment and concurrent enrollment.

South Carolina Lottery Tuition Assistance Program (LTAP) is available for eligible part-time students. The maximum award may change each term but for fall 2015 the estimated award is \$95 per credit hour for eligible part-time students. Requirements are: US citizen, SC resident for minimum of 12 months, minimum of 6 credit hours taken per semester. These funds cover tuition cost only, books not included.
