Ms. Dabney gave the **INVOCATION** BABA, BCB and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. In accordance with the SC Code of Laws, 1976, Section 30-4-80(d), Notice to mediaas amended, Cable 2, the Kershaw News Era, Fort Mill Times and BCBB The Lancaster News were notified of the time, date, place and agenda of this meeting. Dr. Moore recognized Mr. Walker, who referred board members to 2015-16 budget work sessionthe appropriate handouts and reviewed draft budget expenditures DCC and revenues (not including using contingency funds or millage increase) that showed a 5.1% increase in expenditures. Mr. Walker reminded the board of its salary review during the board-superintendent planning meeting in February. The study showed that teachers salaries and substitute pay were competitive with surrounding districts but all other employee groups trailed surrounding counties by 8-15%. He pointed out that the draft expenditures included a step increase for teachers with less than 22 years; • a 3% adjustment in classified, coaching supplement and administrative salary schedules: • a 5% adjustment to Steps 1-6 in the hourly schedule and a 3% adjustment for Steps 7-17; and a \$1.00 adjustment in the bus driver schedule. • After discussion, the consensus of the board was to adjust the bus driver schedule by \$1.50 instead of \$1.00. The board also asked for a comparison of the supplements schedule for non-football sports to the football coaching supplement schedule.
