What We Do

The reboot program is a short-term behavior modification program that serves 3rd- through 5th- grade students enrolled in Lancaster County Schools.

The program assists students to modify behaviors that are affecting the student's academic progress and realizing overall personal potential. The goal of the program is to equip students with skills needed to return to the regular classroom setting prepared to learn and to function successfully in school, in their homes, and in the community.

Reboot uses a positive behavior model with clear and consistent expectations to create a safe learning environment where progress on social and academic goals will occur for all students.

Active parent participation is required in the reboot program. Without parent support, the student will not be able to make the necessary gains throughout the program.

reboot Framework

TRAINING: Reboot trains students, families, and schools to support classroom success. We use a short-term intensive therapeutic model to ensure success for all children.

TEACHING: Reboot uses a small classroom setting with close instructional support to deliver instruction that is aligned with the student's home school and classroom expectations. Reboot also teaches children, families, and schools how to be successful and work together in all environments.

TRANSITIONING: To ensure that every child is ready to return to his/her school, reboot works with student, family members, and the school for a smooth transition back to the home school. Reboot staff will return to the home school with the student to assist with the transition.



Is reboot the right fit for my student?

Does the child...

- Struggle with following directions?
- Struggle with change?
- Have difficulty responding to other students or adults?
- Have a hard time staying focused?
- Become overly emotional or have a hard time controlling emotions?
- Argue with others often?
- Have difficulty following rules?
- Become frustrated or shut down when work is hard?
- Hit or hurt himself/herself and/or others?
- Threaten others?
- Use inappropriate language?
- Bother others frequently?
- Act overactive or distracted?
- Act without thinking?
- Steal, lie, and/or cheat?
- Interrupt others or speak out of turn?
- Have trouble making new friends or display antisocial behavior?
- Have a negative outlook?
- Seek attention frequently?

If the child displays one or more of these concerns, reboot may be the right fit.
