The board reserves the right to remove or exclude any student whose physical condition would interfere with the student's ability to learn or would expose others to infection.

- When a student has been prohibited from school attendance as provided above, the board may require a satisfactory certificate from one or more licensed physicians that the student's attendance is no longer a risk to the student or to others attending school.
- Notification of other students and staff of the existence of a communicable disease will be accomplished in accordance with regulations and guidelines propounded by the Department of Health and Environmental Control.
