Dear Parents/ Guardians,

At this time, Indian Land Intermediate School is experiencing a severe shortage of faculty and staff due to COVID-19. Since school began on August 16, 2021, Indian Land Intermediate School has had about 40 confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among students and staff, and currently has 475 students and staff out due to COVID-19. This represents approximately 50% of the school population. We are transitioning to an online learning model for all Indian Land Intermediate School students beginning Monday, August 30, 2021, until September 7, 2021. All student's instruction will be virtual until September 7, 2021.

Your child's teacher will provide information on next steps and specifics, as these students transition to fully virtual for next week.

At this time, students at Indian Land Intermediate School will resume face-to-face instruction on Tuesday, September 7, 2021.

As always, the safety of our students and staff is our top priority. Thank you for your understanding and for your unwavering support of Indian Land Intermediate School.
