Our social studies curriculum is designed to help children understand cultural diversity and their place in the global community, with an emphasis in third grade on South Carolina history.

- ✓ The curriculum includes grade-specific content standards and social studies literacy skills that span the grade levels.
- ✓ These skills include
 - interpreting calendars, timelines, maps, charts, tables, and graphs;
 - using tables and graphs to interpret geographic trends and relationships;
 - considering multiple perspectives of documents and stories;
 - challenging illogical arguments such as name calling, personal attacks, and insinuation; and
 - gathering and processing information from a variety of primary and secondary sources.
- ✓ The core text is Scott Foresman Social Studies (<http://www.sfsocialstudies.com>), which is used in concert with the study of current and field learning experiences.
- ✓ Correlation of social studies and language arts instruction occurs frequently through the use of supplementary literature and integrated writing assignments.
