

Grading

Grading period

The school year is divided into six 6-week grading periods for elementary students and four 9-week periods for middle school students. High school courses are divided into four 4 1/2-week grading periods each term.

Grading scale

A	B	C	D	F
90-100	80-89	70-79	60-69	Below 60

K-8 – No grade lower than 50 assigned at end of grading period.

9-12 – No grade lower than 50 assigned at end of grading period during first half of course.

Grades per grading period

A teacher must provide students in each class a minimum number of chances for grades each grading period, depending on the grade level.

- Grades 3-5 – eight grades per six weeks in reading and math, six in all other subjects
- Grades 6-8 – 10 separate assignments regardless of weighting per 9 weeks
- Grades 9-12 – five grades per 4 1/2 weeks
