



High School Synchronous: Live Instruction

- A student's class is provided through a live-stream.
- Students follow their daily course schedule.
- Students will be invited on their assigned day (A day = Monday/Tuesday or B day = Thursday/Friday) to login to a live-stream at their appointed time, as indicated by their course schedule.
- Students will be able to hear and to see the instruction as it is occurring within the classroom.
- Students will have the capacity to have additional interaction with their assigned content teachers during published office hours.
- Attendance is expected for each assigned block. Attendance will be handled the same way as if students were in the building. Medical excuses and parent notes must be submitted to the school.
- It is the student's responsibility to follow the make-up work policies that are outlined in the course syllabus and/or student handbook.
- Students are expected to meet daily expectations as outlined by the teacher and by the course syllabus.

High School ASYNCHRONOUS: Computer-Based Instruction

- Asynchronous instruction is only available to students in grades 9-12.
- A student's class is provided through Lancaster County's VirtualSC online learning platform.
- Courses are self-paced, utilizing the provided curriculum.
- A teacher of record will be available for support during designated office hours.
- The teacher of record will be a certified teacher within the content area from the LCSD.
- Students will be provided a course syllabus.
- The syllabus will include assignments, appropriate pacing guides and due dates. (These due dates are non-negotiable.)
- Grading and assessing will follow the Assessing and Reporting Student Progress Document of the LCSD.
- All students will be expected to take a final exam. All final exams will be proctored in person by a district designee (counselor, teacher of record, assistant principal...)
