Middle School



WHO?

- Lancaster County School District middle school students can select the synchronous, live-stream, distance learning instructional model.



*WHAT?

- Class is provided through a live-stream.
- Students are able to hear and see instruction as it occurs within the classroom.
- Students have the capacity to have additional interaction with the assigned teacher during posted office hours and small group time.



WHEN?

- Students will follow their daily course schedule.
- Students will be invited on their assigned days (A days or B days) to login to a live-stream at their appointed time, as indicated by their course schedule.
- A days= Mon/Tues
- B days=Thurs/Fri



WHERE?

- The distance learning option is available at each middle school.



HOW?

- Students and teachers will utilize *Google Meets* and high speed internet.
- Students are expected to meet daily expectations as outlined by the course syllabus and the teacher.

- Attendance is expected for each block and will be taken.
- Medical excuses and parent notes must be submitted to the school.
