

Parent Classroom Observation Procedure

Our district has an open policy inviting parents to observe their children's interactions in the classroom.

The guidelines below are in place to ensure classroom instruction is not compromised.

- All visitors must report to the school office upon arrival and receive the principal's authorization before visiting elsewhere in the building.
- The purpose of the classroom observation is to observe your child. If a parent has concerns about the classroom teacher or curriculum, this should be addressed through a parent-teacher conference.
- Classroom observations should be scheduled with the administration at times that will cause the least interruption of the learning process.
- Classroom observations must be scheduled through the administration for a designated period of time.
