Eligible students will participate in a lottery system for slots in the virtual program. Lottery dates will be set after eligibility is determined.



Eligibility Requirements

- Lancaster County residency
- Yearlong commitment (Elementary/Middle)
- Semester commitment (High)
- Passed all coursework in the 2020-2021
- Less than 10 unexcused absences in 2020-2021



Eligibility Requirements

- Maintain passing grades in 2021-2022
- Broadband Internet connection required
- State required tests will be taken in-person at a LCSD site
- Engage in instruction with an enabled camera at all times



Student Expectations

1. Adhere to the LCSD Virtual Program Handbook and the district's Acceptable Use Policy.
2. Participate in online learning as directed by the teacher.
3. Participate each school day with your camera turned on (elementary/middle).
4. Attend meetings at school, if requested.
5. Request help from the teacher.
6. Complete and submit all work on time.
7. Communicate with your teacher and classmates in a respectful manner.
8. Make sure you have access to Broadband Internet during school hours.
9. Meet attendance requirements.
10. Use appropriate language at all times.
11. Understand coursework will be included in GPA and class rank.
12. Understand that academic dishonesty will not be tolerated.
13. Maintain academic integrity by ensuring that all work submitted is the student's independent work.



Parent Expectations

1. Make sure that your child has the necessary equipment and Broadband Internet access to participate.
2. Provide a safe and appropriate place to work daily.
3. Make sure that your student has enough time in his/her schedule to work each day.
4. Familiarize yourself with your child's Google Classroom.
5. Monitor your child's coursework and progress.
6. Encourage your child to seek help from the teacher.
7. Make sure that all tests and work are completed as assigned.
8. Communicate academic concerns with teachers.
9. Provide Broadband Internet Connection. Please note: Lancaster County School District will not be providing Hotspots or internet access.
10. Maintain academic integrity by ensuring that all work submitted is the student's independent work.
